Buyer Responsibilities

Upon a viable birth and subsequent receipt of the balance owed, the foal will become the property of the Buyer. If the mare does not deliver a viable foal, the Buyer can choose to have a foal from the following year, possibly purchase a different foal as long as both parties agree, or a refund of money paid.

The Buyer is responsible for all costs concerning the foal including but not limited to vet, transportation, registration, and farrier fees with the exception of Keuring expenses.

The Buyer will carry insurance on the foal once it is born, with "Lori Brock" as the first loss payee and continue until the horse leaves the property to be transported to the Buyer's property. The Seller is not financially responsible for the horse in the event of illness, injury or loss of life.

The Buyer will arrange and pay for transportation of the foal from the Seller's property no more than 14 days after the foal has weaned. A \$300/month boarding fee will be assessed after that time.

Seller Responsibilities

Upon receipt of the full payment, the Seller agrees to promptly take all steps to transfer ownership and registration of the foal.

The Seller will provide a safe environment on their property including but not limited to shelter, fresh hay or grass pasture, fresh water and if needed-grain until the foal is weaned at 4-6 months old at no additional charge for board.

The Seller will provide the foal with training and handling appropriate to the foal's age.

The Seller will take the foal to a KFPS Keuring of the Sellers location choice and at the Seller's expense.

The Seller will arrange and pay for a health certificate and Coggins Test.

The Seller will microchip the foal at their expense.
