CEMETERY REMINDERS:

PERMITS

Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical are required for all construction (new building, remodeling, furnaces, water heaters, etc.) New homes on agricultural property need a Special Use Permit from the Twp Planning Commission. All AG buildings need a Zoning Compliance Permit. Permit applications and questions contact Professional Code Inspections (PCI) at 1-616-877-2000. If you remove a structure, notify the assessor to make an adjustment.

FROM ASSESSOR-LISA FREEMAN

Home sales continued to be strong during 2019 resulting in an increase in values for the 2020 assessment year. Land values for all classes (Agricultural, Commercial, Industrial and Residential) increased as well. Building permits are required for new construction including decks, accessory buildings, and additions. Please apply for a demolition permit before you teardown a building. Farmers need to file a use permit for construction of barns. Contact Professional Code Inspectors for all permit information. 1-616-877-2000.

The State of Michigan requires assessors to perform a physical inspection of 20% of twp. parcels each year. Due to COVID-19, I will be_taking pictures from the road. If more information is required, I will send a letter requesting the missing information. Your cooperation has been good; Thank you for that.

ANNUAL BOARD OF REVIEW

Be watching, because in late February you will receive an Assessment Notice. Please review the property value and the Principal Residence Exemption value (PRE). If you feel the information is incorrect, the time to appeal is during March when the Board of Review meets. The Assessment Notice will list the scheduling procedure.
