PART IV - STATEMENT OF FAITH

The AICA Statement of Faith contains the foundational beliefs on which Aquidneck Island Christian Academy is based. These are also the key elements of Christianity that will be unapologetically taught in various ways through all grade levels. The substance of these statements is that which will be considered **primary doctrine** in AICA. Secondary or divisive doctrines and issues will not be presented as primary doctrine. When these secondary types of doctrine or issues arise, students will be referred to their parents and pastor.

Statement of Faith

1. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:26; John 10:30; John 17:21)
2. We believe the Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative Word of God which is *“useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness that the man of God may be equipped for every good work.”* (II Timothy 3:16-17)
3. We believe God created the universe and created man in His own image. (Genesis 1:1, 26)
4. We believe Adam and Eve's disobedience brought sin and death into the world. Man thus alienated himself from God, his neighbor and the world. All are sinners. (Romans 3:23)
5. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father and in His personal return in power and glory. (John 10:25-30; 1 Corinthians 15:13; Hebrews 12:2; Mark 16, 19)
6. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature. We believe that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ; only by God's grace and through this faith are we saved. (John 3:3; 1 Peter 1:3, 18, 23; Ephesians 2:8-9)
7. We believe God calls us into His body to accept the cost and joy of discipleship, to be His servants, to resist the powers of evil and to proclaim the gospel to all the world. (Ephesians 6:10, 18; Matthew 28:19-20; Luke 9:23-25)
8. We believe God has charged parents with the responsibility of bringing up their children in the *“nurture and admonition of the Lord.”* (Ephesians 4:3-6)
9. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 4:3-6)
