

THIRD THURSDAY SEMINARS



In 2007, WEI sponsored and helped teach a Wastewater Regionalization seminar, Nutrient Pathogen Studies seminar, and a presentation on Multistage Activated Biological Process (MSABP) mechanical wastewater treatment systems. In 2008, WEI sponsored and taught an Onsite Wastewater Systems forum and a three-day Certified Floodplain Manager Examination Preparation Course and provided exam proctoring. In 2009, WEI will start what is called **Third Thursday Seminars** that will be held nearly every month of the year. These will all be held at the Mountain View Inn conference center at 420 W 4th S, Rexburg, Idaho, which is contiguous with the Rexburg Area Chamber of Commerce.
