

NOVEMBER 2005

Next item was to look at setting up a special assessment district for a streetlight in Sandy Ridge Estates that exists, but has never been assessed and 5-6 lights for Woodridge Estates. A motion was made by Boerman and supported by Meiste to approve the district. All ayes. Motion carried.
