

MARCH 2008

The regular meeting of the Heath Township Board was held on March 10, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. in the Heath Township Hall.

Supervisor Jones called the meeting to order and Boerman offered opening prayer. The previous month's minutes were approved as read.

Dean Kapenga, County Commissioner presented his monthly report.

The 2008 road work was discussed. A motion was made by Boerman and supported by Schipper to re-approve last years work for reconstruction of 1 3/10 miles of 126th and 1 mile of 38th St., and this years projects of shoulder paving on 128th from 36th St. to M40 and paving 135th from 44th St. ½ mile. All ayes. Motion carried.

A resident asked the board to look at placing a street light on the corner of 136th and 36th. This is the corner where four townships meet. The board unanimously agreed that this would not be a necessary place for a street light at this time.

The recreation board is meeting with the school board tonight to discuss the possibility of the school taking over our recreation program.

Hilda updated the board on the last planning commission meeting and the board is looking at tightening up zoning on summer homes and accessory buildings. The issues with Jeff Lampen and the Trestle Stop have not been resolved and will be taken up in court. The next meeting date has not been set.

The township bills were presented. A motion was made by Boerman and supported by Lindholm to approve the payment of these. All ayes. Motion carried.

The fire department bills were presented. A motion was made by Schipper and supported by Boerman to approve. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Meiste and supported by Boerman to adjourn at 7:45. All ayes. Motion carried.
