- d) The board has contacted Straight Line in regards to shoveling bridges and questioned why the sidewalks are not cleaned down to the cement. Straight Line has the shoes set high on the blower to protect the blades.

6. Zoning update

a) The Planning Commission will be meeting on January 20, 2011 to elect officers and review a site plan. Ron stated he has talked to the township attorney and the Hamilton Farm Bureau may be approaching the planning commission regarding zoning. The

township board feels the H.F. B. needs to apply for industrial zoning and should not be in commercial zoning.
