- e) Hilda met with an individual for a site visit in regards to the park grant .In September a list will be sent with any additions or improvements needed and in December we will hear if the grant was approved.
- f) Outdoor Discovery will be working in the park by the dam to get rid of the invasive species plants. This will be at no cost to the township.
- g) PCI will be issuing a few citations in the township for zoning violations.

- h) Resident questioned what is going to be happening to the Slotman home on the corner of Hubbard and 132^{nd} Ave. The yard is in violation of the obnoxious weeds ordinance. Hilda will be contacting PCI.
- i) Another resident questioned how safe the foot bridge is on M-40. There is also poison ivy and poison hemlock around it.
