# INTRODUCTION

**THANK YOU** for your interest in our products and services. We have tried to make this the most comprehensive catalog of quality diorama supplies available. You may notice it is quite different from others you may have received. The product lines are divided and printed on separate, loose leaf pages. These pages can then be easily and quickly updated as needed. These pages may also be punched for inclusion in a standard three ring binder of your choice.

**HOW TO ORDER :** There are several methods of ordering and payment available. VISA or MASTERCARD are your best choice. You are charged on the day your order goes out and only charged for what you have ordered. Money orders and personal or company checks are accepted. Payment with a check will delay your order by a few days to clear local banks. Yes, cash is accepted although not recommended. All of the information is on the order form (new ones sent with every order). You can mail us the order form or FAX it to us, 24 hours a day, or phone us, 24 hours a day. You may also send us your order via E-Mail. Your shipping, as well as billing, address is also very important as we need to get your order to you. Orders may also be placed through our secure online ordering system

**SHIPPING POLICIES:** We do our best to ship orders in 4 working days of receipt. Allow 3 days for your order to get here (place your order by fax, phone, e-mail or order online to cut this time down) and 3 for it to get back to you. Plan on at least 10 working days from the time you drop your order in the mail box. We ship all orders via Priority Mail unless special arrangements are made. There is the situation of having an item out of stock. If we expect it back in within a few days we will hold your order so it may be shipped as complete as possible. So, all things considered, 10 -14 working days is a reasonable time frame for you to expect to see your order. However, if you are living in another country this will take longer. One way to speed this up is to have your order shipped by air. If you would like air shipment, and this really is the way to go, please double the shipping charges. We do need payment in U.S. funds, please.

**PRODUCT DELAYS:** There are situations where an item can't be shipped for basically one of four reasons. We do as much as possible to minimize these situations but they do occur.

**PRODUCTION DELAY:** When Murphy's Law ("Whatever can go wrong, will go wrong. At the worst possible time.") is the order of the day, sometimes there are situations in the production process that delay a product. This can range from replacing a worn out mold to not getting good parts out of a mold due to the weather (the resin does funny things if it is too humid or too chilly).

**KIT BEING REDESIGNED:** We are constantly looking for ways to improve our kits. The process of redesigning a kit sometimes takes as long as the original design process. However, the "new" kits are worth the wait.

**MATERIAL DELAY:** We also must contend with some parts being supplied by other vendors, decals, etched parts, and raw materials. A delay in receiving these items will cause a delay in shipping some kits.

**OUT OF STOCK :** This situation applies to items by other manufacturers. It is rare but unavoidable. We will let you know when to reorder according to our best information.

**REPLACEMENT POLICY** (for all S.E.Ltd. Kits):

**1.) MISSING PARTS:** Describe the part, with kit number and name, and a replacement will be sent at no charge.

**2.) DAMAGED PARTS (OUR FAULT):** Send back part in question and replacement will be sent at no charge.

**3.) DAMAGED PARTS (YOUR FAULT):** Send back part in question (we all make mistakes) Include \$2.00 for replacement.

For kits other than S.E.Ltd., please contact the manufacturer of the kit. We do not have spare parts for kits other than ours.

**RARE KITS / ITEMS NOT LISTED:** We have worked very hard to include every item we have in stock in our catalog. If it is not listed, we do not have it. Also, we do not deal in rare kits, kit parts, or current production models. All items in our catalog are designed to work with 1/24 - 1/25 scale. We do not work in other scales at this time.

**NEW KITS:** We have some items listed without a price. These are on the drawing board at this time and as soon as they are ready replacement catalog pages will be issued with prices.

**UNPLEASANT BUSINESS:** It has come to our attention that several, unscrupulous people are pirating some, or all, of our products for attempted personal financial gain.

This is totally immoral, unethical, and illegal. People engaging in this sort of activity are not helping anyone. The consumer is getting ripped off with an inferior product and, as a company, we lose sales. This is where the consumer gets the double whammy. As our revenue goes down, so does the ability to design new, original products for the marketplace. So, the consumer loses twice. What this amounts to is stealing someone's work and taking credit for it.

We would like to personally thank you for your interest in our products and/or purchase. We would also like to ask you for your help. First please don't accept imitations! Most S.E.Ltd products are packaged in hanging bags with a high quality header that has our name and address prominently displayed. The parts that go into our kits are of the highest quality material. Everything from the first run styrene, ABS and PETG, the precision milled wood, to the opaque resin. We feel that the best models are constructed from the best materials. Second, if you do see any of the bootleg items, please let us know about it. And fill us in on the details! You know, where you saw it, when, whose name was on the product and, if at all possible, the name of the person selling it. Sending us a sample of the bootleg item would be even better to have physical evidence to prosecute these individuals.

We feel that 99+% of the people in this hobby are good people. It is the fringe element that will ruin a good thing for all of us. We must stick together to keep the hobby we love, and get an enormous amount of satisfaction from, growing and healthy.

**HINTS AND TIPS:** We have received many letters asking about the tools we use in mastering our models. More often than not, there is a preconceived notion that our shop is filled with exotic and expensive tools. This is simply not the case. While we recommend not to skimp when it comes to buying tools, as a good tool is a lifetime investment, we don't believe in foolishly spending money. The following is a brief "shop tour" intended to show that you don't have to take out a second mortgage to build quality models.

**SURFACE PLATE:** We recommend the use of some sort of surface plate to assist in building our, or any, models. In our shops we use several pieces of glass about 5" X 7" as surface plates. We also have an 8" X 10" plate with pieces of coarse and medium grade wet-or-dry sandpaper secured to it with rubber cement. This is very useful in getting a square edge on parts when used with water as a lubricant and moving the part in a figure 8 motion. This prevents one side from becoming thinner or producing a rounded edge.

**PAINTING:** Colors and textures play a very important role in finishing a convincing model. An airbrush is not absolutely essential as our models can be finished with a spray can or brush. However, for the greatest variety in colors and textures an airbrush is the ideal tool. This will produce a thinner coat of paint for a closer to scale look for your models. When you consider the life span of this tool, the cost is very inexpensive. As long as we are talking about cheap, don't be fooled into thinking you are saving any money by buying inexpensive paint brushes that are to be used for applying paint (the exception to this rule would be for brushes used to apply liquid cement; we have found in this situation, the cheaper the better). If your local hobby shop does not stock a quality line of paint brushes check an art supply or craft store. You will be looking for water color brushes, however, don't overlook other kinds for special effects work such as dry brushing etc. A good quality brush, properly taken care of, will yield excellent results for many years. Many of you have asked for our painting techniques. We are happy to share them with you!

**RUSTED METAL:** The best method for producing rust is the RUSTALL system by Kuras Design Group. In lieu of this a good rust color may be mixed with FLOQUIL paint in the ratio of 75 to 85% RUST and 25 to 15% ROOF BROWN.

**PEELING PAINT:** Airbrush model with base color. This may be rust, bare metal, bare wood, etc. when thoroughly dry, daub on rubber cement in a splotchy fashion where the peeling paint is to be. Next, airbrush with your final color(s) mixed with about 20% white. This will give you a "faded" final color. Experiment with this mix to achieve the best color to your eye. As soon as the final color is dry remove the rubber cement by "rolling off" with your finger, a rubber cement

pick up or pencil eraser. We recommend FLOQUIL products as they have worked well for us. We have also used water based paints with these techniques yielding fair to good results. When using FLOQUIL products a nice touch can be added by applying a wash of 20% rust and 80% Dio-Sol. This should be applied right after the rubber cement has been removed and should be "blown dry" with air from your compressor. Be sure to let the base coat fully cure about a week before using the wash.

**PAINTING CONCRETE:** The use of an air brush is strongly recommended to achieve the subtle effects of aging and weather on the surface of pavement. Suggested paint formulas are below. This is a good starting point as these colors may be too dark or light to suit your tastes. All of the colors are made by FLOQUIL and the mixture is for airbrushing. If you are using a brush eliminate the Dio-Sol, Glaze, and Retarder from the stock color. These are base colors and may be weathered with an airbrush and other methods after these sections have been secured to the base. Experiment with the colors until you come up with a combination that pleases you.

STOCK CONCRETE COLOR - 70% Concrete/20% Dio-Sol/5% Glaze/5% Retarder

NEW CONCRETE - Stock Color

AGED CONCRETE - Add 10% Foundation to stock color

SIDEWALK & CURB - Add 10% Foundation & 20% White to stock color

STREET - Add 10 % Foundation & 40% White to stock color

One final thought on color: Asphalt is only very black when it is new. Even then it is not truly black but very dark gray. The perceived color of asphalt will be considerably lighter after exposure to the elements and the friction of traffic. As always observation of the prototype is the best guide.

**PAINTING WOOD GRAIN:** There are many methods for simulating wood grain with paint. If you have a favorite, use it, if not here is one that we have used with great success. Start with water based paint in a medium brown, black, and dark yellow (sometimes called Africa or Desert Yellow) all flat finish. Using a piece of glass as a pallet and a flat brush about 1/4" wide, mix a quantity of paint approx. 1 part brown to 2 parts yellow. This can be accomplished by dipping the brush into the brown, putting it on the pallet, the doing the same to the yellow. There is no need to clean the brush before dipping it into the yellow as it will be a quick immersion and the yellow will not be contaminated. Use your brush to mix the paint. Mix enough of this color for all of your parts. To keep the paint wet while one side of the part is drying, "float" a few drops of water on top of the paint and cover with a styrofoam cup. Paint all parts with this base color and let dry. Mix a dark brown with 1 or 2 parts brown and 1 part black. This will be semi-dry brushed for the grain using different sized brushes for different parts. This should be done with a very light hand and very carefully. Pay close attention as to the way the grain would run in a real piece of wood. A quick dry brushing of brown straight from the bottle and a quicker application of the base color should finish the grain. A few quick strokes of the yellow will add a variation. We never spend too much time on painting an area of a model that can't be seen. This should be painted but the base color will do nicely. When everything has had a few days to set up properly, give everything a quick coat of MODEL MASTER semi-gloss.

**BARE WOOD WITH REAL WOOD:** OK, we know you are thinking "Well, if I am using real wood isn't it the right color?" It is, kinda, but a more real "to scale" color may be obtained by using FLOQUIL FLO-STAIN. For new wood wash the pieces with a 50/50 mix of Dio-Sol and Maple. For slightly older wood follow this with a 50/50 wash of Natural Pine/Dio-Sol. For wood that is really grungy, follow this with a 50/50 wash of Driftwood/Dio-Sol. While we are on the subject of using real wood for our models, we never use balsa wood unless it is in an unexposed, bracing application. The grain is way out of scale and the wood is too soft. It is better to find bass wood. This wood comes in a wider variety usable sizes that balsa and looks much better. It is still a "soft" wood so it cuts easily.

**SANDING:** An emery board is a great modeling tool especially with resin cast items. We used our share of them until we found the black 4-way file available at Beauty Supply stores serving Nail Techs. The 4-way will not clog as easily or quickly as the emery board, is water proof, can be cleaned and water used as a lubricant.

**TOOTHPICKS:** The lowly splinter of wood found all across America, and in better truck stops, is one of the most useful items on our bench. From applying putty and glue, to holding parts for painting, to mixing the paint these little wonders are indispensable.

**FILLER MATERIAL:** Air bubbles are a fact of life with resin castings. We do our best to minimize their occurrence but they do happen. If the bubble is on the back of a casting, which is often the case, simply fill the hole with common baking soda, level it off, and apply fast set CA. This will fill the void quickly. If a bubble occurs on the outside of a casting many times it may be filled successfully with fresh putty (we use BONDO glazing putty). Should you receive a casting with a bubble that you feel you can not correct please send it back, with a note, and we will replace it. Another filler material we use is a home brew consisting of scrap plastic dissolved in liquid cement or MEK. Don't forget to use a small glass jar to store your concoction. One last trick is to use a putty thinned with liquid cement. We have a bottle of TESTORS liquid cement reserved for this use as after the cement is contaminated with putty it becomes useless for building models but, continues to work great for thinning putty.

**TEMPORARY ADHESIVES:** The old artists standby, rubber cement, is very useful around the shop for everything to holding parts in place to securing details in a diorama. Scotch tape, the kind made by 3M, is also used quite a bit in our shops. We have the basic "magic" frosted tape (green dispenser), removable tape (blue dispenser), and double sided tape (yellow dispenser) on the bench. All have different uses and once you start experimenting with them you will wonder how you ever got along without them. The removable tape is excellent for backing small, fragile etched parts when trimming.

**CUTTING DEVICES:** A dull blade is your worst enemy. Change the blade when it starts to drag when cutting. We change blades at least twice a day. Buying them in bulk cuts expenses. We also recycle the old blades. There is a block of styrofoam on the bench that holds the old blades to be ready to apply putty, CA, or hold a part for painting. Rather than applying putty or CA directly to the model we will put a small amount on the surface plate, pick some up with an old blade then apply it to the part or joint. An excellent cutting device that is often overlooked is the single edge razor blade. With the wider cutting edge, and different angle than the #11 blade, this is quite useful in getting a square edge on a part or general scraping chores. Again, buying in bulk saves money.

**TOOL STORAGE:** Blocks of styrofoam, paper towel tubes, and old film cans. These items have one thing in common, they hold tools ready for use on the bench.

We hope this information has been useful to you. One of our goals is to make this catalog a sort of handbook with useful information that you can refer to time and time again. If there are any subjects that you would like to see covered in these pages, please let us know! We are always happy to hear from our customers and your ideas are always welcome.

## WHEELS AND TIRES

Aside from finding a good looking, correct, wheel for a project, the biggest challenge comes for trying to neatly detail paint the the proper areas of the wheel. We have set about to change that situation. When a wheel calls for specific detail painting we provide the trim ring, and as necessary a center cap, as a separate piece so it does not get in the way of the paint. Chrome plated parts are supplied as appropriate. All wheels are sold in sets of 4 with generic wheel backs.

In selecting a wheel/tire combination for your project don't be too concerned with the scale they are being marketed as. Rather use the actual dimensions to determine how appropriate the part is for the application. A correct "look" will produce a much more pleasing representation. All of our separate tires are furnished in sets of 4 (except flats), molded in a beautifully authentic black urethane rubber, with markings (unless noted).

Flats are available in Series 24641, 24642, and 24645 and priced at \$5.00 each.

Any tire size may be ordered with any side wall markings by including the appropriate suffix in the order number. When tires are ordered without a suffix, they will be shipped without markings, as

a black wall.

Tire dimensions are shown in real inches and may be changed at any time in an effort to provide a superior product. While any change will be very small, if a project is dimensional critical it is recommended to call or e-mail for the latest information.




