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# The Mariner North Resort - A five star wilderness resort located in the heart of an emerging real estate sanctuary



The Mariner North holds a very large place as the premier hospitality center in the history of Copper Harbor. First established in the 1920's, it was called the

Pontiac and was a thriving Inn / Restaurant / Bar as Copper Harbor launched its tourism era into a summer resort community with the shuttle service on the Copper Queen to Isle Royale National Park and the establishment of Fort Wilkins State Park.

Over 40 years later it changed hands and became known as the Keweenaw Inn North. The fresh air, gorgeous scenery, and the draw of Lake Superior made Copper Harbor a natural escape from the city confines. In 1977 Don and Peg Kauppi bought The Keweenaw Inn and renamed it "The Mariner North".

The early days of The Mariner involved the development of the snowmobile program to assist Copper Harbor in its goal as a year round tourism destination area. In the early 1980's a first floor addition almost doubled the size of the Mariner building and 9 new motel rooms were added to the second story. This progress was fairly short lived as a fire occurring in 1991 completely destroyed the entire Mariner complex.

In 1994, the main Lodge of the Mariner North was completely rebuilt and reopened by Peg and Don. In the following two years, the cabins, game room, and four unit motel were built. The nine unit, two story motel was built in 2001 to complete the Mariner North Resort as it operates today.

#### The Mariner North offers a true Four Seasons of fun:

<u>Winter:</u> Snowmobiling, cross country skiing, and snow shoeing in fresh snow on groomed trails. We get in the range of 300" of snow each year. Some of the most challenging skiing and snowboarding in the country is just a few miles away at Mt. Bohemia.

<u>Spring:</u> Hiking and mountain biking...as we take March and April to regroup & enjoy ourselves we close the resort for six weeks

<u>Summer</u>: Lots of vacationing here...swimming, boat tours, biking, hiking, summer programs at Michigan Tech and Finlandia University. A lot of popular attractions like Ft. Wilkins, Eagle Harbor, Lighthouse tours, and if you miss the old routine there is always golf at the scenic Mountain Lodge or Michigan Tech's course in Houghton.

<u>Fall:</u> The Keweenaw, especially Copper Harbor, features some of the most spectacular fall color shows as our huge variety of trees change color and are framed by our huge population of evergreens and rugged hillsides with winding roads that are colorful tree shaded tunnels. And...if color is not enough, all of our summer attractions still afford opportunities to experience the Keweenaw as it was years ago.

A very nice feature of the Mariner is that you can enjoy yourself, by yourself—or with others. The Mariner restaurants and bar seem to know no strangers.....they have become the 'Cheers' of the North. The Mariner North provides very good settings for weddings, family reunions, sports outings and community activities as well as for corporate conferences, sales meetings and outings.

#### The Mariner North — Main Lodge



Built in 1994-2001, the Mariner North provides the only modern luxury motel accommodations, restaurant, lounge and resort in Copper Harbor. Located on a full block of frontage on US41 – Main Street Copper Harbor — the Mariner welcomes visitors to Copper Harbor and area attractions...



The Formal Dining Room, which includes a built in salad bar and electric hot table buffet, seats ninety at eighteen hardwood tables and ladder back chairs. The dining room features a large fireplace and 25 foot Cathedral ceilings and is wrapped with three sides of exterior windows for outdoor viewing and natural lighting.



The Mariner's Great Lakes themed North Woods Cocktail Lounge seats one hundred forty two at hardwood tables and booths as well as at the signature birds eye maple bar. This is the place for entertainment and good times—day and night – any season of the year. The great

sandwiches (yes, they all have Mariner type names) and fresh made pizza served here are renowned throughout the Keweenaw Peninsula.



Opening off the North Woods Cocktail
Lounge is the seven hundred and sixty square
foot Game Room with two house owned Pool
Tables and contracted video games, dart board
and juke box.. A great place to just hang out.

#### The Mariner North — Accommodations



Each of the five spacious two story log cabins, built in 1997, has nine hundred square feet of very usable space. Each cabin has two bedrooms and storage upstairs. And....



Downstairs in the Log Cabins you will find a full living room with a fireplace and a hide a bed, a fully equipped kitchen and a spacious bathroom with an oversized whirlpool. Each Cabin has its own front board walk entrance.



. Eight rooms in the Nine Unit Motel also have patio doors which open to the outside with balconies on the second floor. The ninth guest room, referred to as the Honeymoon suite, has even more space and amenities.



The rooms in the Four Unit Motel each have two queen sized beds, a wet bar, a refrigerator and an oversized Whirlpool in the bathroom. The couch also makes up into another bed. The units are fronted by a common porch & boardwalk.


These are just some of the community involvement activities that Don and Peg have been a part of - and in many cases spearhead with their seemingly boundless energy:
