

## Summer Camp Checklist

Full Class A and Class B uniforms(s) – as complete as possible (i.e., Scout shirt, shorts, belt and socks).

Last year's pipestone

One pair of sturdy hiking boots with good ankle support

One pair of tennis shoes

Six blank or Scouting related T-shirts

Two pairs of long pants (one required) or jeans (jeans can be hot, recommend light weight pants)

Five pairs of shorts (long pants that zipper off to make shorts cut down the number of shorts needed)

Belt

One long sleeve (cotton shirt), required

One sweat shirt (hoodie)

Underwear (6-7 pair)

Socks (6-7 pair of each), recommend heavier sock with hiking boots

Personal hygiene items

- Soap
- Shampoo
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Dental floss
- Medications
- Comb
- Chapstick
- Mouthwash
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Hydrocortisone/Benedryl cream for stings/bites

Shower shoes (flip-flops or beach shoes)

Two towels (bath and beach)

Swim suit (wear under uniform for Sunday swim test)

Flashlight

Pocketknife (only if you have Totin Chip card)

Spending money for trading post and merit badge classes, if needed

Heavy pad (foam pad or tarp to cover bed springs or wooden bunk)

Sleeping bag including a light sheet

Backpack and/or small duffle bag (We hike in all personal gear – don't bring more than you can carry!)

Notepad, pencil or pen

Blank or Scouting related hat

3-foot long whipped knot rope

Scout Handbook

Merit Badge prerequisites

Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)

Pipestone wood  
Water bottle or canteen  
Head strap for eyeglasses, if you wear them  
Fishing pole (optional, unless you are taking fishing merit badge)  
Camera and film (optional)  
Snack food (optional)  
Sunglasses  
Shorts or sweat pants for sleeping  
Pillow (optional)  
Wrist watch  
Drinking cup or mug  
Hanger for your uniform in your tent (optional)  
Clothes line to dry towels in tent or hang uniform (optional)

What not to bring!

Radios  
Walkmans  
Cell phones  
Walkie-talkies  
In general, no electronic devices  
Soft drinks  
Mess kits
