The Somersworth NHES/NHWORKS office offers a wide range of services, tools and resources in NHES) Resource Centers and the NHWorks Community Action Workforce Development Programs, including tours for schools and education programs, career and job search workshops geared towards youth, a yearly youth career fair. Youth can receive one-on-one assistance or utilize self-directed resources in looking for work, assessment, resume development, accessing labor market information, career planning and training. Eligible individuals may qualify skill assessment, employment counseling, job referrals and/or placement, individualized career planning and follow up services in the Workforce Development Program.
