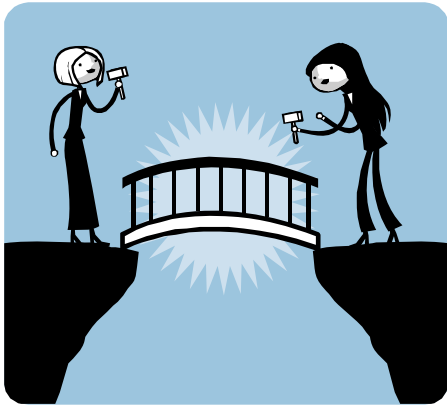


Building an Alliance

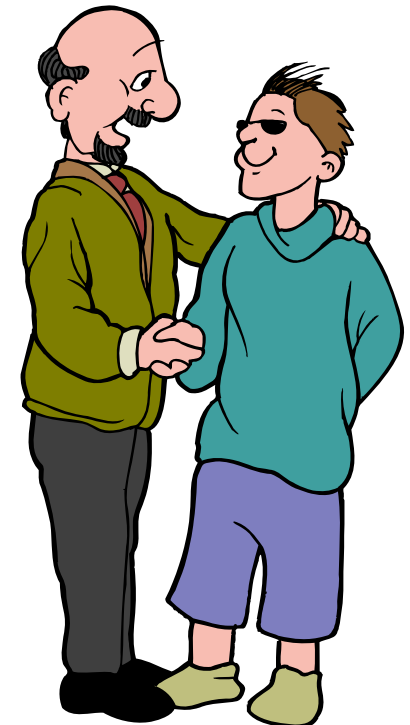
