Minutes

June 5, 2007

The regular meeting of the Tompkins Township Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the township hall by Supervisor John Tuttle. Members present in addition to the Supervisor were Clerk Melanie Curran, and Treasurer Linda Sterrett. Trustee Gary Purcell and Trustee Nancy Seydell. The minutes of the **May 1, 2007 Regular Meeting Minutes were approved** following a motion by Sterrett, seconded by Seydell.

Feb. 2007 Regular Meeting Minutes were amended to add the approval of the Jackson County Sheriff Dept. Roadside Pickup. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion was carried.

Treasurer's report was read as: Disbursements of \$41,281.75, deposits of \$31,592.73, and a balance of \$120,572.78. The report was approved following a motion by Seydell, seconded by Purcell. **Budget Amendment:** Moved to amend the budget for contributions - \$8882.78 and Fire Protection Equipment the same, accept from Virginia Allison Tompkins this amount, and prepay bills in the same amount for the new firewell by Curran, seconded by Sterrett. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried. **Vouchers for the fire department** bills were read. Moved to accept the vouchers by Curran, seconded by Sterrett. Motion carried.

Moved to promote the historical qualities and make a historical donation to Fairview Cemetery and Lincoln-Pomeroy Cemetery and prepay the bill by Curran, seconded by Sterrett. Roll call: all yes. Motion carried.

Road Commission / Dust Control Moved to approve the expense of dust control on the 7.09 miles of unpaved roads of Tompkins Township at a cost of \$1,772.50 by Sterrett, seconded by Seydell. Roll call votes: all yes. Motion carried.

Communicaitons: Supervisor John Tuttle issued one permit for a fireworks display within the township in accordance with the law and in conjunction with ATF (federal).

Public Comment was opened at 8:30 p.m. with no comments received and the meeting continued.

Two building permits were read by the Supervisor.
The meeting was adjourned at 8:37 p.m. with seven in attendance.
